## AWAKENING -

## An Invitation to Prepare for an Easter Awakening!

his Easter (April 4), will be more significant this year than in a generation. In the wake of 2 million deaths from a global pandemic, a polarized political nightmare that won't stop, and deep unrest, injustice and pain across racial lines, it is time to engage the Lord at a new level – a deeper level.

We live in a farming community. We understand that in order to have a harvest, we must first sow the seed. 2 Chronicles 7:14-15: ...Be AWAKE to this...

"If my people, my God-defined people, respond by humbling themselves, praying, seeking my presence, and turning their backs on their wicked lives, I'll be there ready for you: I'll listen from heaven, forgive their sins, and restore their land to health."

Rather than "grumbling" about the state of world, God calls us to "humble" ourselves. That means that we are to put God back in control of our life. And as we do, we can see a change in us... in our church (the church is the people)...our community and our world. **Thy Kingdom Come.**



# **Administrative Board Meeting Minutes**

February 2021

he Administrative Board met via Zoom video conference on Wed., Feb. 10th at 6:00 pm. Bill & Theresa Berriman, Rodney Altes, Carol Kimberley, Julie Warner, Lowell Halfhill, Bob & Marilyn Matthews, Jeri Heffelfinger, Kent & Dawn McKee, Bob Pease, Jolene Brady, Chairman Bob & Barbara Leonard, and Pastor Phil were present.

Pastor Phil opened the meeting with prayer. Bill moved to accept last month's secretarial report as printed in the church newsletter. Motion was seconded by Julie and passed.

Treasurer Theresa presented the financial report for approval. Deposits totaled \$x,xxx.xx. Debits totaled \$x,xxx.xx. The balance on the checkbook statement was \$x,xxx.xx as of January 31st. All accounts balanced. Theresa explained that the Business Money Market account is what used to be the savings account. When the accounts were transitioned over to Bank Iowa, they did not offer a savings account at that level, so it is an interest bearing checking account. Motion to approve the financial report was seconded by Jeri. Approval given.

As a continuation from last month's discussion on the aging furnaces, Bill shared details regarding the cost estimates from both Brookwood and Baxter Comfort Solutions (BCS). It was determined that BCS offers the best package for our situation. Our current service contract with Brookwood runs through October and since the ACs are not quite as old, we hope to get through the year and wait until September or early fall — after the AC season, but before heating is needed and then replace both furnaces and ACs at the same time. BCS also offers a service contract and yearly maintenance plan which would be a good investment. The quotes are good for only 30 days, but Rodney and Bill may visit with Bryan DeJong from BCS, to see about perhaps making a downpayment. They will also negotiate add-ons, such as a HALO UV air purifier and automatic humidifier, as well as apply any rebates that might become available at the time of installation. The farm account could be utilized to cover the cost. Bill made the motion that both the church furnaces and AC units be replaced this fall. Motion seconded by Kent. Motion carried.

Rodney reported that Scott Miller replaced the two windows that had been leaking in the south basement classroom. Theresa noted that the bill has been paid. Bill mentioned that Larry Beard will work on building window well covers. Bill also shared that he made a walk-thru of the church. A security light had burned out near the ramp, but all else seems to be in order.

It was noted that with the frigid winter temperatures forecast for this weekend, in-person worship services will not be held at the church this Sunday, Feb. 14th. Service will be by Zoom only. Bill shared that he and Theresa have been recording attendance each Sunday.

There was no UMW meeting this month.

Pastor Phil shared his report. An Ash Wednesday service will be held via Zoom at 7:00 pm on Wed., Feb. 17th, featuring sackcloth and ashes, and participants will also have the opportunity to share in communion. The current sermon series on the Apostles' Creed will finish up the first week of March. The next sermon series on "Planting Seeds for a Great Awakening" will begin in March. Confirmation classes will continue through Easter with Easter Sunday on April 4th, and Confirmation Sunday to follow on April 11th, when we will welcome the new confirmands into the life of the congregation. Pastor also shared his thanks and gratitude towards Theresa, Barb, and all of the many helpers who worked to put the statistical reports together. Pastor also shared a letter from the District Superintendent Heecheon Jeon, thanking both church congregations for paying 100% of the annual apportionments.

The February monthly Local Mission Giving donation of \$100.00 was sent to Colfax-Mingo Post Prom. Jolene mentioned that a Prayer Chain request had gone out regarding a little boy, Andrés, with a congenital heart defect in need of a heart transplant. His parents own the Cratty Shack in Colfax and a GoFundMe account called "A Heart 4 Andrés" has been set up in his name. Theresa made the motion that March's \$100.00 donation be given to the family for Andrés. Motion seconded by Dawn. Motion passed.

Bob M. moved that the meeting be adjourned, seconded by Bill. All prayed "The Lord's Prayer" together in closing.
