September 2022

he Administrative Board met via Zoom video conference on Wed., September 14th at 6:00 pm. Bill & Theresa Berriman, Janice Gregerson, Rodney Altes, Bob & Marilyn Matthews, Jeri Heffelfinger, Carol Kimberley, Kent & Dawn McKee, Kevin & Jan Borts, Nichole French, Jolene Brady, Chairman Bob & Barbara Leonard, and Pastor Phil were present.

Pastor Phil opened the meeting with prayer. Bill moved to accept last month's secretarial report as printed in the newsletter. Seconded by Carol K. Motion passed.

Treasurer Theresa presented the financial report for approval. Deposits totaled \$X,XXX.XX. Debits totaled \$X,XXX.XX. The balance on the checkbook statement was \$XX,XXX.XX as of August 31st. All accounts balanced. Motion to approve the financial report was seconded by Kevin. Approval given.

The Mingo UMC will once again host Trunk or Treat – this year it will be on Saturday, Oct. 29th, from 3:00 - 5:00 pm. Janice made the motion for the church to purchase an outdoor banner to be displayed along Hwy. 117 and Main St. to advertise the event. The banner will cost \$106. Seconded by Kevin. Motion carried.

Jolene has been offered and accepted a full-time position with the City of Newton and will be retiring from all church positions and duties the end of this month (September). Replacement duties for Jolene were discussed and are to begin October 1st, 2022.

*It was discussed that around 3/4ths of all of the texts sent out on EZ Texting are for the Prayer Chain. This would be difficult for Reyna to do since she is in school. She could send out the general church messages, but we will still be looking for a volunteer to help with the Prayer Chain Ministry who might be available throughout the daytime. Jolene also noted that Reyna will need to contact Lori Pease so she can "friend request" her. The Mingo UMC Facebook page was created as a page on Lori's personal account. Once they become Facebook "friends," then she will be allowed to post to the church Facebook page.

Financial Duties / Reconciliation of Accounts:

Theresa Berriman will assume the financial duties of the Mingo United Methodist Church School checking account and credit card, and the Mingo Youth Fellowship checking account. Marilyn Matthews will be the second signer on these accounts. Jolene Brady and Janet Beem will be removed from both of these accounts and Theresa Berriman and Marilyn Matthews will be added to both of these accounts. A transfer of these names will be requested at Bank Iowa.

Jolene will be in contact with Nicki and Reyna to send them the information they need to hopefully facilitate a smooth transition of these duties.

Bill moved to accept the "Replacement Duties Plan" in its entirety, with the transfer of Jolene's duties to end on September 30th, 2022, and new appointments to begin on October 1st, 2022. Marilyn seconded. Motion carried.

Jolene reminded everyone that the newsletter deadline is next Tuesday, Sept. 20th. It was also noted that World Communion Day will be celebrated on Sunday, Oct. 2nd. Dawn will provide Jolene with the address for the Kentucky mission / disaster relief, so a check with the remaining Red Bird Mission funds will be sent to them.

Pastor gave his report –

- 1. Sunday, Sept. 18th will be the "Loaves & Fishes" service and celebration at the Quarry in Colfax. All churches are invited to attend. Farrar & Mingo will still have their regular morning worship services. The service at the Quarry will be from 11:00 11:30 am with a 12-noon meal. Main dishes will be provided, but you may bring a side dish to share and chairs for sitting if you wish. The fun and festivities will run from 12-noon 7:00 pm. All families and friends are invited.
- 2. Study groups will be starting up on Sunday, Sept. 25th and run through October. They'll be held in the Mingo church sanctuary from 4:00 5:00 pm and will focus on the four main elements of beliefs.
- 3. Sunday, October 16th will be the Charge Conference held at the Newton UMC at 3:30 pm.
- 4. "Task Force" committee members include Rodney Altes, Kevin Borts, Marilyn Matthews, and Pastor Phil. They met on Aug. 25th and Sept. 13th to discuss the topic of human sexuality in relation to the United Methodist Church. They will collect any questions the congregation may have and lay out a plan to take back to the Board and the congregation with answers and information.

Jeri noted that the remaining Matthew 25 Grant funds were used to replenish school supplies and purchase items for the Trunk or Treat event. Jeri will be writing up a report to share with us on how the \$5,000 was spent and all of the blessings it provided throughout the year.

Everyone was reminded to come help support Jeri's Garage Sale which the proceeds will go towards our girls in Uganda. The Sale will be Thursday, Sept. 15th and Friday, Sept. 16th, 8:00 am – 6:00 pm.

As previously discussed, the September Local Mission Giving in the amount of \$100.00 was given to Women at the Well. Theresa made the motion that October's Local Mission Giving in the amount of \$100.00 be given to the Salvation Army, November's donation will go to the Food Pantry, and December's donation will go to Hope Ministries. Seconded by Janice. Motion carried.

Janice moved that the meeting be adjourned, seconded by Bill. All prayed "The Lord's Prayer" together in closing.


